After reading/listening to these stories, you can ask your child the following:

- What happens in the beginning of the story? In the middle? At the end?
- Who are the characters in the story?
- Where does the story take place?
- What is the problem in the story? How is it solved?
- If you could write another ending to the story, what would it be? Why?
- What was your favorite part of the story? Why?

• Can you find any rhyming words in the story?

We also suggest working with your child over the summer on:

- → Writing their first and last name
- → Identifying and writing letters of the alphabet
- → Identifying and write numbers
- → Identifying color words
- → tying their shoes
- → buttoning their pants
- → washing their hands correctly
- →using the bathroom independently
- → taking turns with others/waiting their turn
